JEANNE AUSTIN – POPOLOCA, MEXICO, Wycliffe

The Atzingo and the San Marcos translation teams are working on the book of Isaiah. We plan to publish the first part of the Pentateuch/Old Testament and sell it for a third of the cost. Pray the people will respond positively. Our church is growing and Covid has not been as bad this year. Prayers for people that are discouraged and not attending, especially young adults. Pray for another preacher for the Atzingo church.

HANNAH AND JARED BAKER – NORTHERN AFRICA

We have many refugees that had to flee their homes. Their lives are on hold with no legal work or schooling while they wait for interview that could grant resettlement. Many look to smugglers to take them from Tunisia to Italy by boat with no guarantees.

Our Counter-Trafficking and Vulnerability Reduction Project is working with 15 women for business training for certification. Also, involves training and education for human trafficking.

BIGIMBA NGABO – GOSHEN MINISTRIES

2022 Purchases of two houses in Uganda saving on rent. Constructing another classroom building and getting a second campus to expand the four grades. Remodel Tucson facilities into three apartments for refugee transitional housing. Provide two different refugee congregations services in Tucson. Pray for wisdom about what the Lord may want for Goshen in 2023.

ROY AND JULIE EBERHARDT – OAXACA, MEXICO, Wycliffe

Roy met with his IT department that he supervises. They have an updated server and email system. He has been working with another missionary we support, Peter Wulfin in the media arena. They both attended and set up the internet connection for the EURASIA MEDIA DISTRIBUTION CONFERENCE. Nine countries attended outside Mexico City. They came to teach and learn media tools for the spread of the Gospel. Prayers for the different translation teams.

BEN AND CHRISTY McCLURE – REACH CAUCASUS – TURKEY/AZERBAIJAN

They are based in Batumi, Georgia, bordering Turkey and Azerbaijan. They are one of three couples who have had extensive experience in serving in Turkey. We need to train many native workers to spread the Gospel and for them to make new disciples. Our strategy for the future is to use social media to spread the word. Pray for more Turkish/Azerbaijani speaking staff. For guidance for team as we design our curriculum for 2023.
